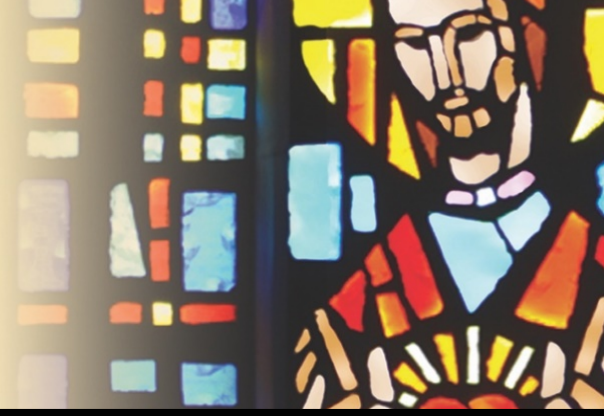

Congratulations, Dr. Lee, on the reception of this prestigious research grant!



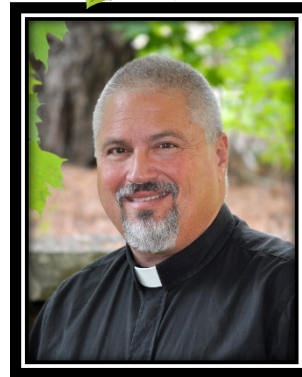
