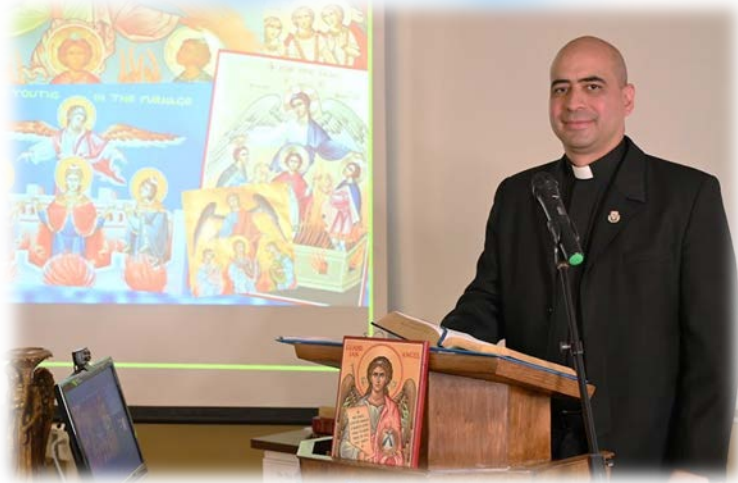
Congratulations Mr. Pedro Ruiz Aular!

CALL TO ACTION

CHANGE IN US IMMIGRATION POLICY

On September 25th, the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) proposed a rule that will limit the time that international students have to complete their academic program. If the change goes into effect, students will be granted a program time of four years, two years for language studies students. Students will need to petition DHS if additional time is needed to complete their degree.

This will significantly impact students at Sacred Heart Seminary and School of Theology.

- **The Program for Priestly Formation exceeds the fixed program time**
 - Students bridging from ECSP to MDiv require even more time
 - Students lose the option of pursuing a dual degree, MDiv/MA
- **Master of the Arts and English and Culture Studies Program students may be limited to two years**
- **Students will have to petition DHS to ask for additional program time**
 - Students will be responsible for their own petition and any associated legal costs
