

Wisconsin hits 6M vaccine doses; hospitalizations high

Six million doses of the COVID vaccine have been administered in the state as of this weekend. More than half of Wisconsin residents are fully vaccinated, but that number is not keeping pace with the delta variant surge.

Hospitalizations remain high, as does the seven-day average of daily cases, which is nearly one thousand cases per day more than the average of one month ago.

Cases of the delta variant continue to rise as well.
